# **Best Secret Islands on Earth**





### **Chile: Robinson Crusoe**

A two-hour flight west of Santiago, this rugged isle earned its fame from the 18thcentury sailor Alexander Selkirk, whose wild spell as a castaway here inspired the novel Robinson Crusoe. The aura of adventure still endures (there s even a rumor of buried treasure). Travelers arrive on a seven-seater plane, then take a 30minute speedboat ride to the town of San Juan Bautista. At the new Crusoe Island Lodge (Bahía Pangal; 56-23/460-103; crusoeislandlodge.com; doubles from \$330, all-inclusive), all 15 rooms are made with recycled materials and wood from the nearby forest. Hire guide Michelangel Trezza from the hotel to organize a scuba dive (from \$150), on which you II see a centuries-old shipwreck.
